

Medical Nutrition Therapy (Core Medical Service)

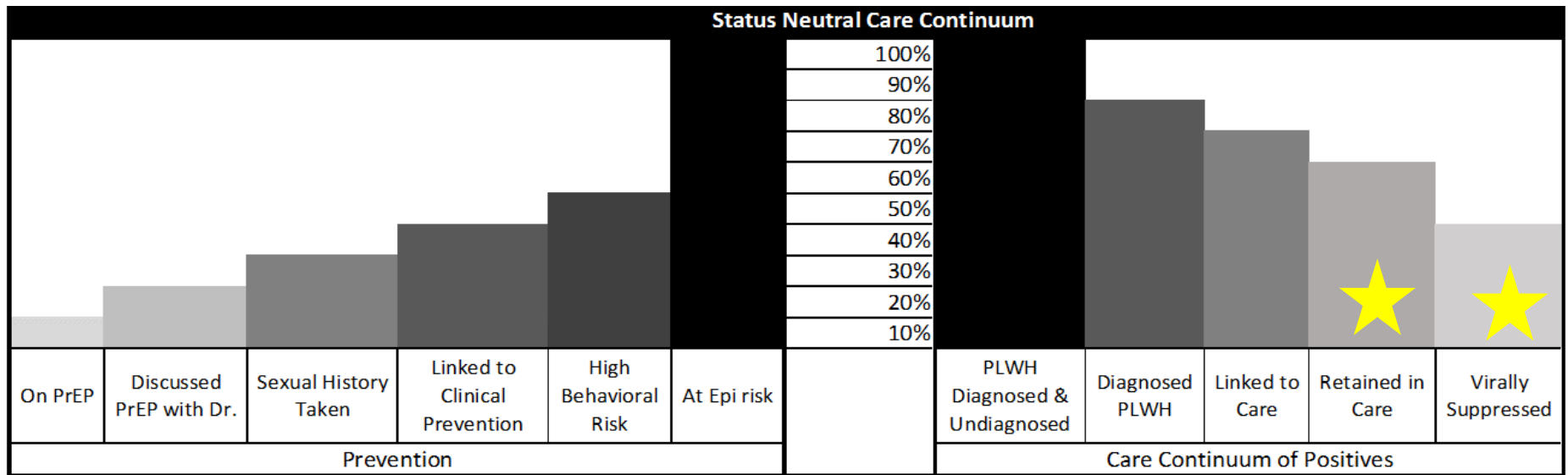
HRSA Definition: Medical Nutrition Therapy includes:

- Nutrition assessment and screening
- Dietary/nutritional evaluation
- Food and/or nutritional supplements per medical provider’s recommendation
- Nutrition education and/or counseling

These services can be provided in individual and/or group settings and outside of HIV Outpatient Health Services.

This also includes the provision of essential non-food items that are limited to the following:

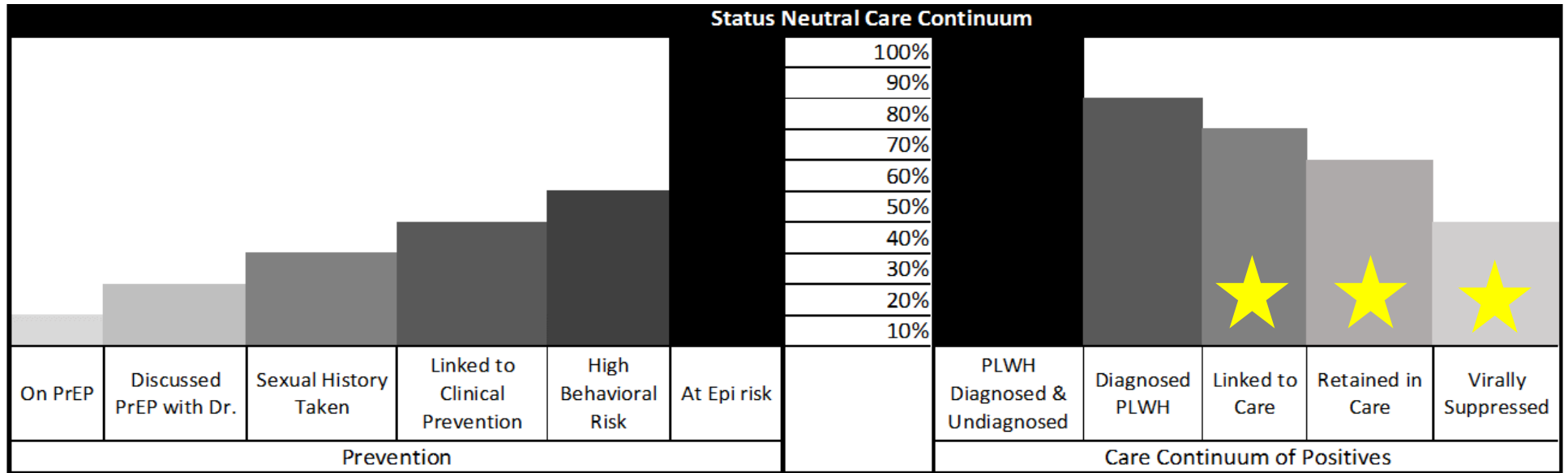
- Personal hygiene products
