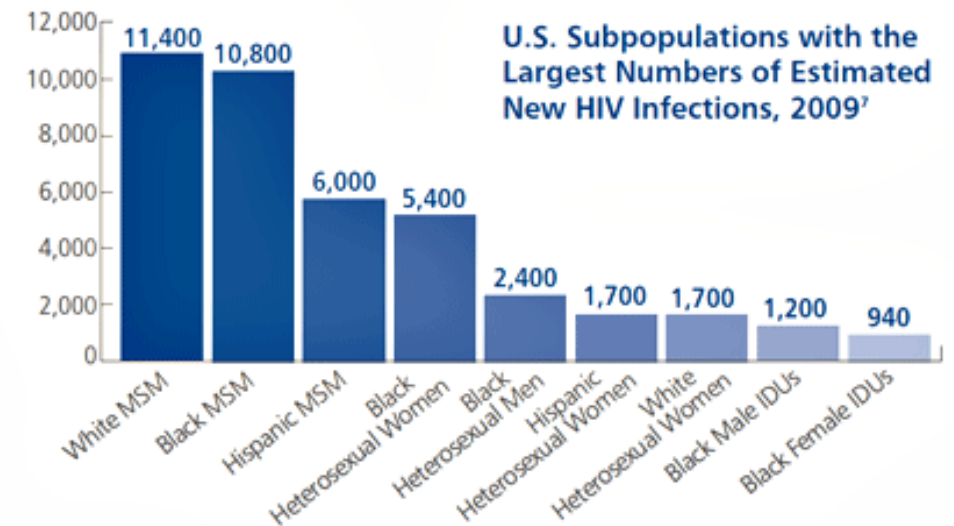


7-County Metro Area Populations

- HIV Testing:
 - 1) MSM (158.1 per 100,000)
 - Black (20.8% of Metro MSM, 3.8 rate)*
 - Hispanic (10.1% of Metro MSM, 1.6 rate)
 - White (61.9% of Metro MSM, 0.8 rate)
 - 2) Black Women (34.8 per 100,000)
 - African-American (95% in Metro)
 - African-Born (89% in Metro)
 - 3) Transgender (13.8 per 100,000)
- Syringe Exchange
 - MSM/IDU, 77% of all IDU in Metro
- Prevention with HIV-Positives
 - All populations



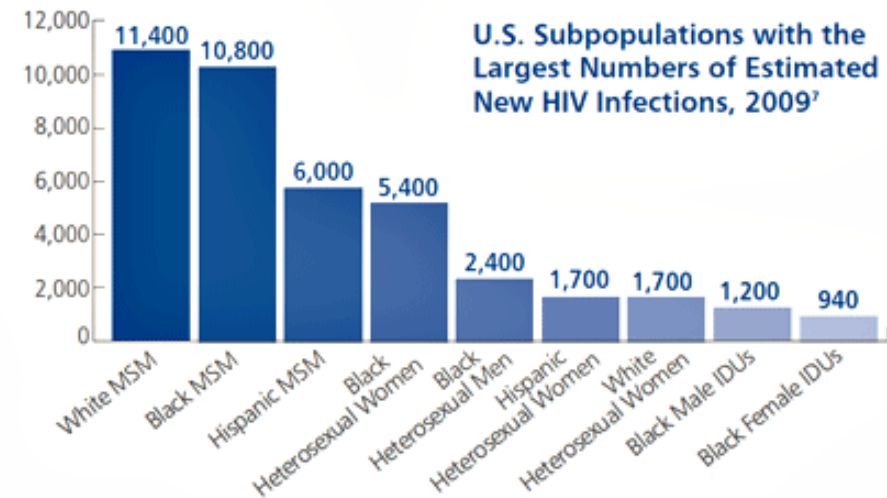

Greater Minnesota Populations

17% of new HIV cases, need to target

- HIV Testing:
 - All MSM (51% of all new HIV)*
- Syringe Exchange:
 - All IDU (50% IDU, 50% MSM/IDU)
- Prevention with HIV-Positives
 - All populations
