FY2021 Part A Year-end Reallocation Proposal

Assessment of Part A expenditures as of November 30, 2021 indicates that the substance abuse services/outpatient Part A allocation will be underspent by \$59,400. Food insecurity among PWH continues to increase, exacerbated by the surge in COVID transmissions, which is anticipated to continue at least through the winter as the omicron variant becomes dominant. The Part A recipient proposes to reallocate \$59,400 in Part A funds from substance abuse services/outpatient to home delivered meals. The Part A home delivered meals allocation was fully spent by October 31, 2021.
