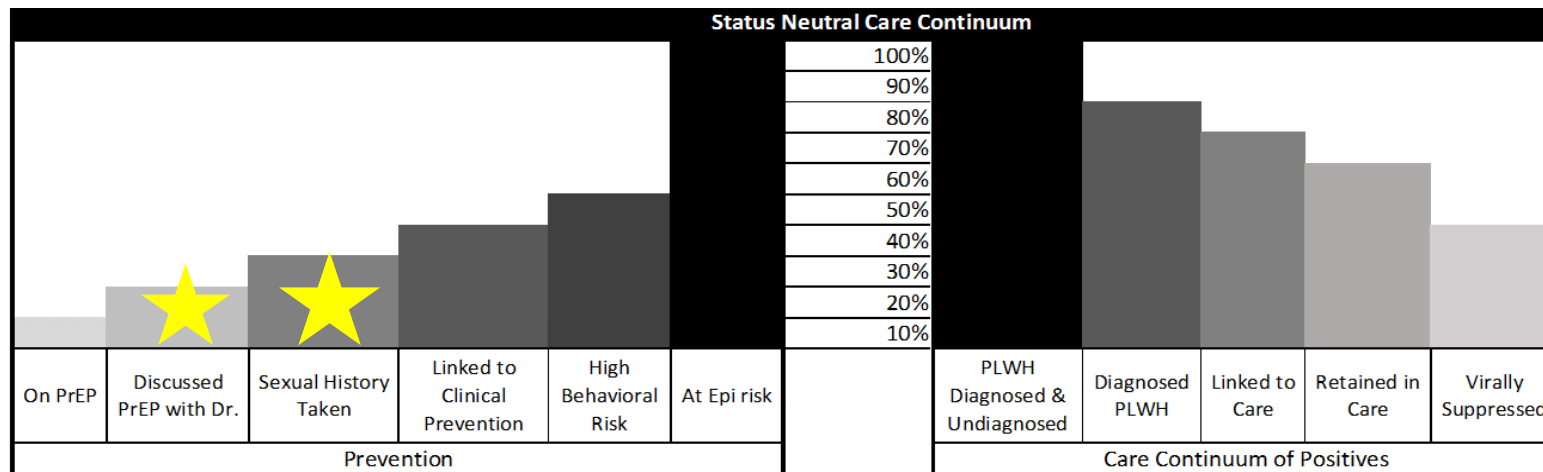


Prevention with Positives

CDC Definition: The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recommends prevention with positives (PWP) for people living with HIV as part of the high impact prevention strategy (HIP), that is a re-enforcement of treatment as prevention (TasP) that is aimed at reducing new infections. Key components include:

- Increase linkage to care
- Increase re-engagement to care
- Support treatment adherence
- Risk reduction- condoms, safer sex practices
- Partner engagement for HIV negative: to increase HIV testing and PrEP

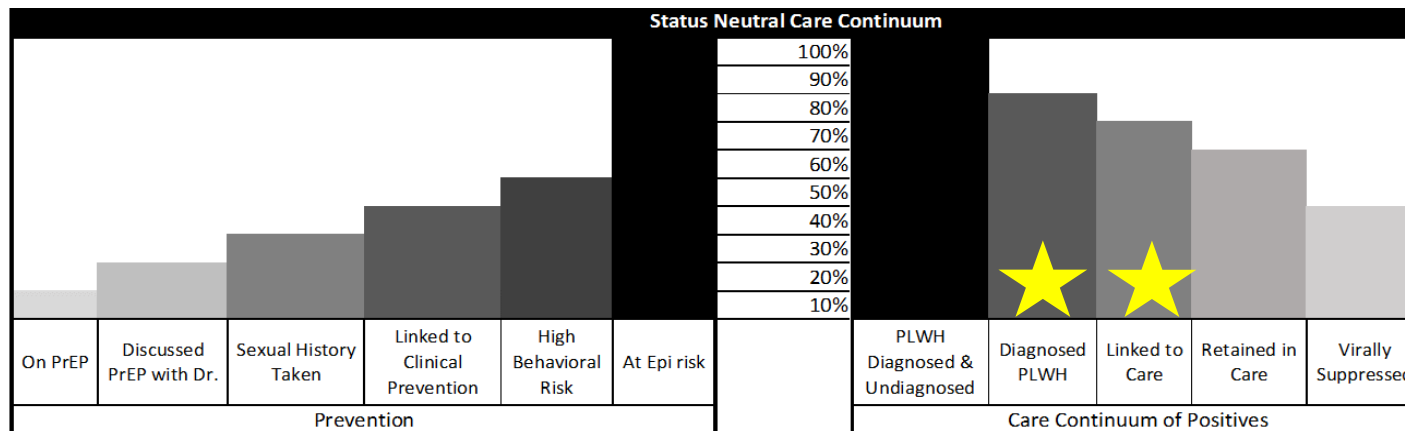
Early Intervention Services (EIS) (Core Medical Service)

HRSA Definition: The elements of EIS often overlap with other services, however, EIS is the combination of such services rather than a stand-alone service and must include the following four components:

- Targeted HIV testing to help the unaware learn of their HIV status and receive referral to HIV care and treatment services if found to be HIV positive
- Referral services to improve HIV care and treatment services at key points of entry
- Access and linkage to HIV care and treatment services such as Outpatient/Ambulatory Health, Medical Case Management, and Substance Abuse services.
- Outreach Services and Health Education/Risk Reduction related to HIV diagnosis
