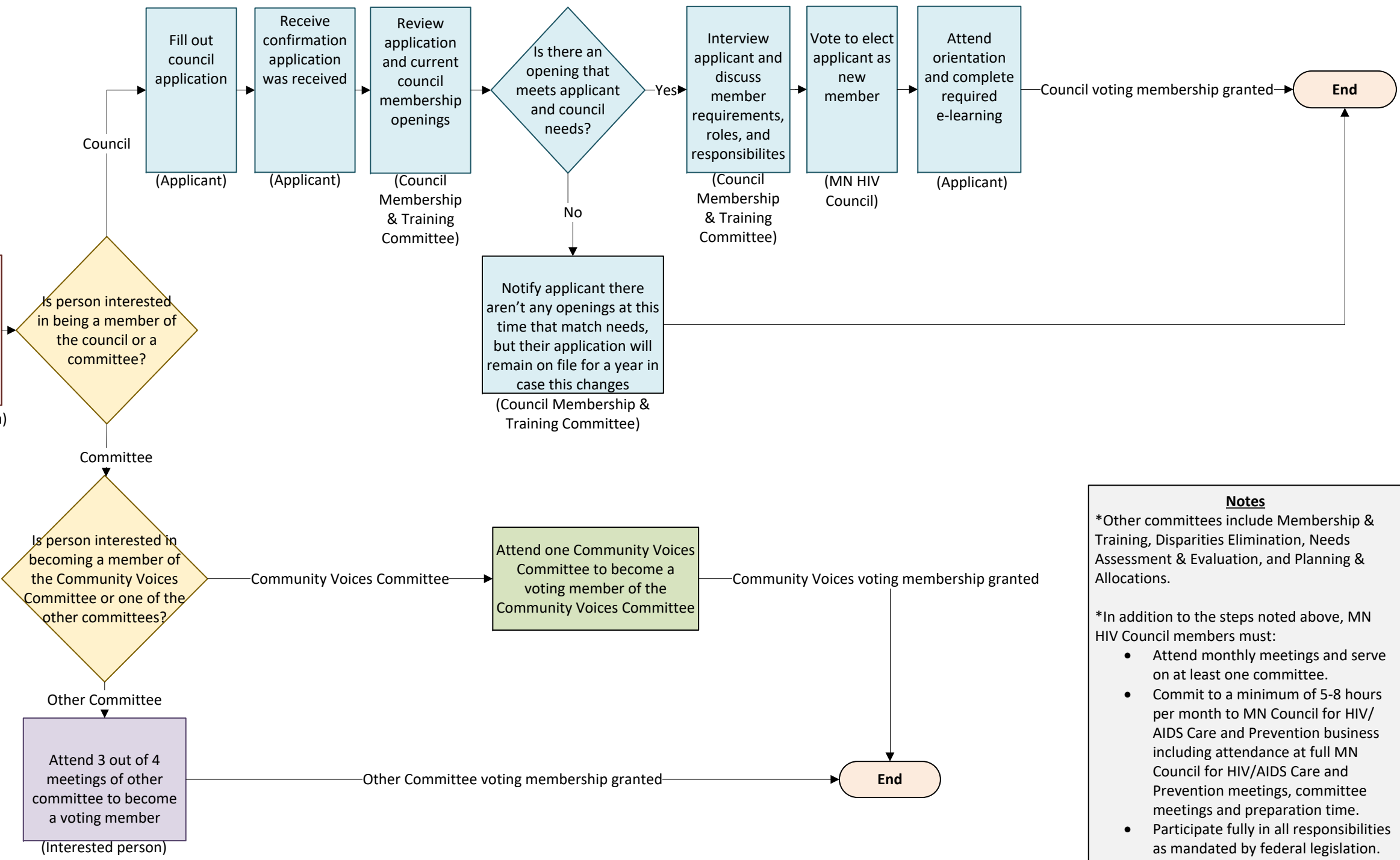


Becoming a Member of the MN Council for HIV/AIDS Care and Prevention and Its Committees

*In addition to the steps noted above, MN HIV Council members must:

- Attend monthly meetings and serve on at least one committee.
- Commit to a minimum of 5-8 hours per month to MN Council for HIV/AIDS Care and Prevention business including attendance at full MN Council for HIV/AIDS Care and Prevention meetings, committee meetings and preparation time.
- Participate fully in all responsibilities as mandated by federal legislation.
